The Irish know how to have a good time and very often they get enjoyment in the pub to the accompaniment of Irish folk music.

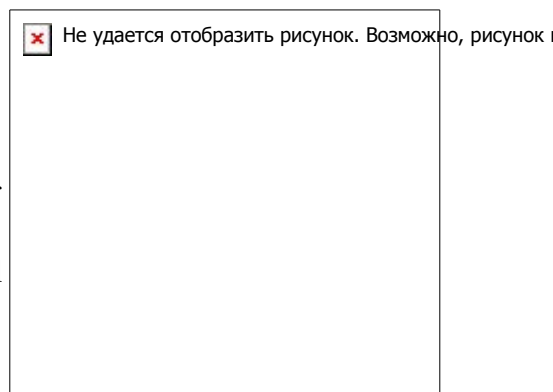
